



Deep Dive In onQloud Ransomware 2022 Guide

There is no other type of cyberattack today that is more prevalent, pervasive, and damaging as ransomware. With nearly 200 active ransomware families, it's no surprise that 87% of organizations rank cyberattacks as the

number one threat to their business. With small- and medium-sized businesses with less than 100 employees representing 49% of all ransomware attacks in the second quarter of this year, and with the median company size impacted by ransomware sitting firmly at 100 employees, ransomware is an even larger problem for SMBs:

- The average downtime after a ransomware attack is 24 days³
- The average cyber insurance claim for an SMB in the first half of 2022 was \$139K
- 47% of SMBs would only survive 3 days after an attack, with another 28% only surviving a total of 7 days

And with ransomware gangs constantly evolving their techniques, new players entering the field, and the realization that SMBs have less-than-adequate security and/or backups in place, as well as the growing presence of cyber insurance, it's clear that the SMB is a primary target for ransomware.
